The paper is a good experiential narrative by a person having first-hand experience of the study samples. I find the document useful; however, it is quite generic in a few sections. It is unnecessarily long while also missing the innovative advocacy for future institutions. The numbers and requirements are well documented. However, I maintain that it needs improvement to be taken as a scientific contribution. Presently, it looks more like a report.

Further, some of the observations require a literature backing, although I respect the experience-based observations. Indeed, proofreading and typo errors are too many throughout the manuscript.

I hope the authors take the feedback as constructive and that the revisions are well-taken.
