

## Review of: "A New Record of Henckelia Infundibuliformis for India From Arunachal Pradesh"

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Potential competing interests: No potential competing interests to declare.

In general, a new record is published based on the disjunct distribution of a species. Henckelia Infundibuliformis has been described from Tibet as an adjacent area of the state of Arunachal Pradesh. Phytogeographically, both fall in the same category. This is not proper to say as a new record. Since the species has extended its distribution towards India, it should be considered an addition to the flora of India.
