Addiction Ontology

Definition: A combustible tobacco-containing product that is a thin small cylinder of dried leaf containing finely chopped tobacco.

Comment: These are usually hand-rolled and include flavouring. They are popular in India. The smoke is usually inhaled into the lungs and so for public health purposes they should be classified with cigarettes.

Curator note: We used 'has part' rather than 'contains' for the relation with tobacco because the bidi is the whole object including the tobacco.

Ontological definitions can sometimes be hard to read. In those cases we also include an informal definition.

Definitions also often require elaboration to make it clear how they should be used and what they include. In those cases we include a comment.

Also, definitions sometimes require an explanation as to how they came about to help users understand how they relate to alternative definitions. In those cases we include a curator note.
