

Review of: "Study on Disability and the Right to Emotional and Sexual Life"

I would like to thank you very much for this article which I think is very informative. I think that sexuality among the disabled is often neglected from researchers and your article covers a gap in this area.

Regarding your text I think that you have some points that need your attention.

Your title is not accurate. It does not help the reader understand what your article is about and how you have address this issue (I mean either qualitative or quantitative).

Your abstract is missing some information. Although you state the aim of the study you don't mention anything about how you treated these stories (the method you used, the methodology, the techniques) or any results. Also, there is no mention on limitations of this study and no mention on future directions.

Your Introduction is good but there are some paragraphs without references. For example on the 2nd page in Emotional responses the first sentence needs to be refrashed. How do you know that these are the main emotions in every human that reads this? How do you justify that? Is there a reference to back this? The same also stands for the next sentence. You need to reference your claims. Finally, the last paragraph on page 3 needs references too.

In structural vulnerabilities you did an excellent work. Well done! The only comment I have is that I advice you not to write with pronouns as "we" but prefer pronouns more general eg. "one might think..."

In page 5 paragraphs 2-4 needs references.

The same stands for the paragraph that begins in page 5 and continuous in page 6.

The same also in page 7 and the first paragraph in page 8 along with conclusions.



Although you have used excellent data and the stories were very powerful addressing basic problems people with disabilities face, I didn't quite understand how you treated these stories.
