

# Review of: "Are high medical costs incurred by people with disabilities excessive?: An empirical analysis of Korean National Health Insurance Data"

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This is an interesting article but could be more informative in the result sections This article provided nationally representative information on the medical cost of people with and without disability in Korea. While the authors discovered that multivariate analysis tended to give a more accurate estimation of the difference in medical expenditures between people with disability and without, it is a bit confusing about the policy implication from such a result. As the author categorized disability into different types, it would be very interesting to see detailed results across these disability types, which may indicate the disability types that need more support from the government.
