- **Setting:** The author should describe the study setting and why this setting. Other aspects included in the setting should be taken to appropriate sections, i.e., design, type of data obtained, and sampling method used.
- Study design: What is under this section should be taken to the appropriate section, i.e., 225 students to go to sample size, and consent to the ethical considerations section.

Results

- Tables 1 and 2: Should be adjusted so that they fit on one page.
- Abbreviations should be written in full on first use, such as OLS.
- Figures 2, 3, and 4 should be adequately labelled.
