

## Review of: "Study of the Problems of Determining Public Opinion of the Israeli-Palestinian War in Social Networks"

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Potential competing interests: No potential competing interests to declare.

- Limited Discussion on Data Validity: While the article acknowledges challenges with data verification, it lacks a robust discussion on how these issues may impact the reliability and validity of findings.
- Narrow Scope: The study primarily examines public opinion on a specific topic (Israeli-Palestinian conflict) on Reddit.
  The applicability of findings to broader social media platforms or other geopolitical contexts remains uncertain, limiting the generalizability of results.
- Neglect of Socio-Political Context: The article predominantly focuses on technical aspects of sentiment analysis,
  neglecting broader socio-political dynamics shaping public opinion. Incorporating socio-political theories or frameworks
  could enrich the analysis and provide deeper insights into public opinion formation.
- While the article provides a high-level overview of the methodology, it lacks specific details on the machine learning and natural language processing techniques employed, as well as information on the dataset used (e.g., size, collection method, validation).
- The article does not present any quantitative evaluation metrics or comparisons to other approaches, making it difficult to assess the performance and effectiveness of the proposed algorithm.
- The discussion of the challenges and limitations associated with public opinion analysis on social media, such as the potential for manipulation and the representativeness of the data, could be expanded to provide a more well-rounded perspective.
- The article does not clearly articulate the specific research questions or hypotheses that guided the study, nor does it discuss the potential real-world applications and implications of the findings.
