This article has some weaknesses that I will discuss below.

- 1- The title of the article should be written in line with the work done. It seems that the research done is a systematic review, but the title shows a research work.
- 2- The abstract part needs to be rewritten. The working method is not specified, the type of study, the year of conducting the study, and the time period of conducting the study are not known.
- 3- The introduction part is long and referencing is not done well. Very long paragraphs without proper references.
- 4- The study gap has not been addressed, and the necessity of conducting research is not clear.
- 5- The materials and methods part is not clear.
- 6- The text of the article is very long; there is a need to rewrite the article in a specific framework.
- 7- It is necessary to present the findings in the form of appropriate tables and graphs so that the information can be conveyed to the reader more quickly.
- 8- The conclusion part is very long; the final conclusion of the research should be briefly discussed.
- 9- It seems that the text of the article does not match the number of references. An article of this length has only 26 references.
