Some hypotheses on population increase are not quite supported; for instance, "...a high number of artificial breeding sites, and a high number of unmaintained breeding pockets, accompanied by massive human activities in an effort to control vectors, have resulted in an increase in mosquito populations..."

The final remarks and conclusions are not based on solid arguments; it seems like a not-under-review paper. The document needs, most importantly, better references to sustain arguments for both sections.
