The "competition" between digital and classroom attendance learning is still an actual issue. The appreciation of blended learning raises attention to understanding both sides and developing an optimal mix of teaching and learning methods. That manuscript can make a great contribution to the body of knowledge, and repeated surveys in different countries may allow a broad dataset.

The structure and the scientific soundness of the manuscript are correct. I can accept the preliminary validation of the survey questionnaire. At the same time, there are some shortfalls. The content and the analysis are quite superficial; only some main results are presented. I think that there is more in the survey. I miss formulating hypotheses and giving responses to them. I also missed a separate point for the conclusions with more implications.

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
