Congratulations on the presentation of your case.

I suggest you enrich your contribution by adding to the discussion the possibility of closing the defect by catheterization, this being a possibility in a small defect in patients without pulmonary hypertension and being a less invasive option than surgery with good results in expert hands.

Although there is the option of maintaining conservative and expectant management, the risk of endocarditis will be present as long as the defect remains. I suggest you add some comments on this.

I congratulate you for the emphasis you place in your writing on physical examination, which has unfortunately been replaced by paraclinical studies.

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
