The topic is interesting and topical, but apart from the general descriptions, it is not clear what was actually investigated, with what aim, or how the results of the research are presented in a scientifically acceptable way. Here are some comments: - The introductory text lacks references; - In chapter 1.3, the challenges for engineering education should be explained in more detail using the sources cited by the authors - such claims are too general; - Chapters 1.4 to 1.13 also lack references (there are probably some references to what is quoted); - It is not clear from the article how the research was conducted or what the actual results of the research are; - It is not clear what is discussed in the "Discussion" chapter; - The conclusions are not based on research findings. - The article does not fulfill the minimum criteria of a scientific paper.
