Comment 2. The difference between this work and the literature should be stated clearly. Comment 3. Are there any proximate and ultimate analyses of bamboo?

Comment 4. How do you know you produce bioethanol and bioethylene?

Comment 5. The experimental procedures are not clear; for example, how do you perform the second stage with peroxide, thereafter filtering the first stage solid? ... yeast to dry or wet biomass? Is there any shaking during fermentation? Step 6 is not clear! ... All the experimental procedures given as results in Table 1 should be explained in the experimental section.

Comment 6. Discussion should be enhanced.

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
