

Review of: "Evaluation of Ambient Air Quality Level at Various Locations within Lead City University, Ibadan"

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Potential competing interests: Air Quality

The author tried to analyze the air quality status of a University by considering a few air pollutants over a defined period of time. The study completely lacks scientific endeavor and has not been structured properly. No hypothesis has been built, while the analysis includes just the description of the data obtained. Some of the major comments are as follows:

- The author talks about the impact of industrial activity on air quality in the abstract. How can industrial activity influence the air quality at any university?
- The entire text needs sentence restructuring at multiple points.
- All the sections, including Introduction, Methodology, and Results and Discussion, are poorly built and make it difficult
 to follow up with the objectives of the study.
- Objectives and research questions are the same.
- The study provides very limited scope as it is subject to a specific university which lacks significance over a larger level.
- The text has plenty of redundant information. It needs a lot of improvement.
- The paper has a poorly designed sampling plan. Not structured properly.
- The graph does not show all the readings. Needs improvement.

There are many other points I could write about regarding the paper, which in no case ensures positive perspectives for the text. In its current condition, the paper is not fit for publishing.

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
