There are many grammatical and mistyping errors. Whole text should be checked by a native english speaker:

Along the whole text, unnecessary capital letters are used.

In Abstract: same tense should be used in one sentence(e.g. "Higher temperatures also initiated chemically eagerness of Ti6Al4V and reacted with cutting tool edge and escorts towards catastrophic failure"

In Abstract: a better verb could be used instead of "follows"

In Abstract:the term "the worse effect of Machinability to" is not understood

In Abstract: "...and coating which is chemically inert and has excellent..."

In Abstract: "...resulting in ultimately ....

Introduction - 3rd sentence: Another word will be better instead of "however"

Introduction: "...The reason of why Ti6Al4V is ...." also the rest of the sentence is not understood

Introduction: sentence containing "at the phase change cutting zone caused by increased thermal conductivity" is not understood, it should be rewritten

Introduction: "Ti6Al4V is need to machine with green manufacturing concept under the sustainability approach" should be rewritten

Rest of the article is not checked. first whole manuscript should be checked grammatically.
