- Extensive language editing
- Introduce section 3 on Methodology, which makes results and discussion section 4 and conclusion section 5
- The table on page 7/32 should be table 1, which changes the numbering of subsequent tables
- Section 3.1 should be Socioeconomic Characteristics or Profile of the study area
- Merge tables 2 & 3 to make them more concise and eliminate repetition and redundancy
- The conclusion section has some subheadings in bold, which are not conclusions per se. Therefore, contextualize within conclusion or policy impact/recommendation
