The definition of an injury was made in accordance with the accepted international ice hockey norms. An IRS was completed when one of the following criteria was observed:

- any injury sustained in a practice or a game that prevented the player from returning to the same practice or game;
- any injury sustained in a practice or a game that caused the player to miss a subsequent practice or game;
- a laceration that required medical attention;
- all dental injuries;
- all concussions;
- all fractures.
