- 1. The title should be "The Effect of Cinnamon on Cancer Progression and Prevention" instead of the title given by the authors, since the first idea discussed in-depth in the review is the progression of the disease, while the prevention was mentioned in brief at the end.
- 2. The abstract is well written.
- 3. In the introduction, the authors write about the anti-diabetic effect of cinnamon. This part is not really needed since it is not the main idea of the review.
- 4. It is not mentioned clearly in the text how cinnamon, or its components, can regulate (by activating or inhibiting) NF-kB, AP-1, VEGF, etc., pathways and therefore what the role of cinnamon is in the prevention and progression of cancer, as described in the title.
- 5. It would be good if the authors could summarize the previous studies in a table showing the active component used, type of cancer, and whether the study was in vitro or in vivo.
- 6. Add figures to describe the discussed pathways and illustrate the active components of cinnamon interaction within these pathways.
- 7. In general, the review needs language editing to correct it grammatically.
