

Review of: "Adolescents' Knowledge of Sexuality in a School Context: A Descriptive Study"

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Potential competing interests: No potential competing interests to declare.

This is an interesting topic of concern to society and the scientific community.

Authors are recommended to use the data collection approach of organising a training workshop before administering the research questionnaire.

The study design is coherent and strong, particularly in the choice and use of assessment tools to measure the outcome variables (the QCS and the QACSES).

However, there are a few minor comments I would like to highlight:

Please, could you verify the source of your argument in the first sentence of your introductory paragraph?

Though you stated the aim of the study in the abstract, this has not been clear in your introduction.

What are the justifications for your participant selection? For example, was it based on age, or was it that the other grades were on vacation/not available?

You were very clear on how the QCS was used to measure knowledge about sexuality. Could you elaborate more on how the QACSES was used to measure attitudes and beliefs about sexuality? It is equally useful to that as well.

Overall, the study has value and adds to new knowledge.
