From my point of view, the main topic of the study is nothing new; it is perfectly known that patients who are already diagnosed with liver diseases will consequently have alterations in liver enzymes. The title of the paper does not generally correspond to the development and content of the work, since liver function tests include enzymes and bilirubin. So, of course, do synthesis tests such as albumin and INR, which are not considered in the paper. The results seem to me to be of little relevance given that the studied population has already been diagnosed with some liver disease and that already conditions a bias, since these patients will of course have alterations of these tests.

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
