The paper demonstrates overall quality, with only a few minor corrections suggested. These corrections may include italicizing the botanical name and correcting the author citation in the title. Additionally, it is recommended to ensure that the abstract is concise. Furthermore, reasons for selecting leaves and stem bark should be provided, along with references for their uses. If dried materials are used, their morphology/macroscopic characteristics should also be included. The introduction should start with an appropriate first line, and the vernacular name can be added after plant details. To enhance clarity, additional paragraphs can be added to cover plant introduction, common names, uses, phytoconstituents, etc. Lastly, minor grammatical errors should be checked and corrected.
