Good study, but it is recommended to authors to relook some of the points below.

- 1. Grammar; Line 1 in introduction; Giardia intestinalis should be in italic
- 2. Method; Line 4, extra comma.
- 3. Acronym ART was not explained elsewhere.
- 4. Why patients came for stool examination was not explained, was it volunteer? Or referred by doctors for further investigation? If so, what was/were the presenting features?
- 5. When stool collection was done; how it was transported?
- 6. Bivariate analysis (chi square only); with more than 2 stratas in selected factors, in my opinion inadequate. Revised analysis are needed so that the factors can be identified clearly. I would suggest further analysis with multiple logistic regression.
- 7. Results were poorly presented, why authors selected only few factors..on what basis?
- 8. Results also were poorly discussed.

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
