

Review of: "Outcomes of Rezum Water Vapor Therapy for Benign Prostate Obstruction with One-Year Follow-Up: Largest Real-World Data from Türkiye"

Rezum as a MIST for ablative procedures on the prostate is an exciting prospect. Having said that, longer follow-ups and prospective randomized studies with proper blinding are necessary to compare with the gold standard, i.e., TUR-P. The authors have done interesting work on the efficacy of Rezum as a procedure for ablative treatment of benign enlargement of the prostate. It would be great if the authors could have a relook at the inclusion factors, where they state a peak flow of 15 ml or more as one of the inclusion factors, which is not the case as it is a normal flow. As a presentation of the facts from a single centre, the study is interesting, and I would be looking forward to a head-to-head comparison with TUR-P in a double-blind, prospective randomized study design.

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
