

Review of: "Racial Composition and Perceptions of Microaggressions: Implications for High School Counselors"

This is a well-written and thoughtful manuscript. The literature review and discussion tied together nicely and cited well-respected authors in the area of microaggressions. I found the design and analysis interesting. I was particularly interested in the framing of prior environments. As the authors noted, the sample size was small. The fact that the authors found significant differences in reporting of microaggressions based upon prior environments in such a small study suggests replication of the study with a larger sample would be warranted. The high number of African American participants was a clear strength of this study, given their particular experience and history within a U. S. context. The authors should make similar efforts to include African Americans in future studies.
