The paper "Shaping an Ethical Future: A Comprehensive Review of Child Ethics in a Global Context" addresses a topic of great relevance and pertinence in the current context of globalisation and technological advances. Through a multidisciplinary analysis, the author explores various factors that influence children's ethical and moral development, highlighting the importance of family, education, culture, and intercultural interaction.

It is therefore interesting, but there are some areas for improvement: a) The content should be revised because the terms moral and ethics are not synonymous; b) The methodology used lacks a clear and defined set of criteria for the selection of studies. The adoption of a more systematic approach, such as the use of the PRISMA methodology, could significantly improve the structure and clarity of the review process; c) The discussion section of the article is not sufficiently robust. A more in-depth and critical discussion of the findings, relating them to previous studies and highlighting the practical implications of the findings, would be beneficial.

Again, the paper is commended and thought to be of great value. We encourage a review of its content.

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
