While reading the manuscript, I noticed a few minor areas that could benefit from further clarification.

1. It would be helpful to include a brief explanation of the functional and neurophysiological changes that occur during each stage of epilepsy. For example, authors could discuss how brain function is altered during the ictal stage and how this leads to symptoms such as exhibitionism.
2. Please put the reference for this sentence "Despite this caveat, the existing literature suggests that behaviors like exhibitionism or arson may occur during the ictal phase of TLE, and psychotic episodes during the postictal phase."
