I find it interesting to study the ethical side of climate change. I believe that this aspect could also be addressed in the paper in more detail.

On the other hand, I agree with other reviewers that the article could be more neutral, being a bit pessimistic and making several mentions during the text of a possible nuclear conflict. This should be pointed out, but it is not the objective of the article, as indicated in the title. I suggest to the author that there are also other risks to civilization, such as pandemics, food security, among others, that are related to climate change.

As for the mention made to the Vatican, I also add that it can include aspects of the encyclical *L'audato Si'* published by the pope, in defense of our common home.
