In general, the work is very interesting in the line of research on female entrepreneurship. Women play a fundamental role in micro and small businesses in emerging countries.

In item 2, Review of the literature, there is a lack of greater depth regarding the barriers that women face in accessing financial services. Although the work focuses on Uganda, it would be important to know if these barriers also occur in other countries, African countries, for example.

In item 3, Research methodology, it would be important to indicate how many articles have been reviewed regarding the barriers that prevent women in Uganda from accessing financial services. In general, an acceptable literature review should contain at least 60 reviewed articles.

Item 4, Results, shows the types of barriers that women in Uganda face in accessing financial services, but it would be important to know the order of importance of these barriers, perhaps in the future with a questionnaire applied to women in Uganda. This could be more precise, given that the studies cited are somewhat old. On the other hand, the table suggests that each study has identified only one barrier. A bit weak for an investigation.

Finally, I hope that these comments serve to strengthen the work and that it can be perfected in the future.
