The paper focuses on conducting a systematic review of antibiotic use in humans in Nigeria. Interesting data and an important topic to explore from a global health perspective and as a strategic approach to controlling antimicrobial resistance. However, there are some clarifications needed.

1. What are the inclusion criteria? Because the authors only mentioned the keywords and language.
2. The paper's timeline, January 2000 to January 2017, is quite far from 2024, and I am afraid something has changed in Nigeria.
3. Using Medline via PubMed and African Journals Online (AJOL) databases only is very limited; the author can add more publishers.
4. The data from paediatrics, only 2 articles, cannot represent the whole of Nigeria.
