In the sentence: Comparing the local almond samples with the control... or in this: mathematically outperformed the control sample... What is the control? Is there a control in this procedure?

In the sentence: Likewise, with regard to the content of flavonoids, it is noted from Table 6 that there were only two samples that contained these compounds... Maybe it would be preferable to write something like: Regarding flavonoids, only in two samples were possible to quantify total flavonoids according to the method used.

The authors have written:

The studied cultivars/samples were divided into two main groups. It is also noted that this corresponds to the collection area.

I am sorry, but after analysing the figure, I am not able to see such two groups according to the collection area.

This manuscript can be accepted after major review taking into account those remarks.
