

## Review of: "Shaping an Ethical Future: A Comprehensive Review of Child Ethics in a Global Context"

The article seems very interesting to me and, above all, very important. Congratulations on choosing the theme. It is well written and structured. To help improve the article, I have 3 points to mention (they are the ones that seem most important to me):

- 1. There are few references throughout the text. I think that when there is a relevant statement, there must be a reference that confirms that statement. As this is a literature review study, this is even more important. For example, the concept and lexical origin of "ethics" is presented without any reference, which does not seem appropriate to a scientific study of this type. Another example is the point "Multidisciplinary analysis," which does not present references. It would be useful to present references from each of the areas mentioned as important for the topic of study.
- 2. The point "Research Methods" (which also has no references) is poorly explained. It needed more explanation or a more complete description. In the case of a literature review, it should describe the criteria used to include or exclude documents; what platforms were used in the research; how many documents were selected and how many were analysed and in what areas. It was also important to know how the investigation evolved: for example, did the factors mentioned result from the analysis of the documents, or were they defined a priori and from these came the criteria for selecting the documents? Was multidisciplinarity identified after analysing the documents, or was it a starting point for the selection of documents?
- 3. The definition of the objective of the study is also a little confusing (at the end of the introduction and at the beginning of the conclusions). It does not seem to me that "this scientific article examines the formation of ethical values and norms in children within the context of globalization," but that it summarizes/identifies the factors that influence the ethical and moral development of children, through a review of the literature and focusing on globalization.

I hope these contributions are useful to you in improving the article.
