

Review of: "Seismic intensity measure selection considering Record-to-Record and Angle-to-Angle uncertainties."

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Potential competing interests: No potential competing interests to declare.

The authors conducted an interesting study on the selection of seismic intensity measures. My suggestions are as follows:

- (1) A more comprehensive literature review is required, particularly related to A-to-A variability, to justify the motivations of this study and to highlight the novelty of this study.
- (2) It would be better to explicitly illustrate the limitations and assumptions adopted.
- (3) Try to maintain an academic writing style throughout. For example, the following sentence in Section 2 should be revised:

Original sentence: To account for this impact, one needs to conduct nonlinear analyses to evaluate the seismic performance of the structure in various rotation angles.

Suggested revision: To account for this impact, nonlinear analyses are conventionally required ...

(4) It would be better to include a conclusion section after Section 5 (Results), summarizing the main findings in this study.
