Here are some of my suggestions to make the research better:

- 1. While the introduction covers a wide range of relevant literature, it could benefit from a clearer structure. Consider organizing it more logically into subsections that clearly introduce each relevant aspect of the theoretical background and previous research.
- 2. Although the two research questions are clear, consider expanding on why these specific questions are important and how they align with the gap in current literature.
- 3. Explicitly state the gap in the current literature that your study aims to address. While it's implied that spatial imagery techniques are less explored compared to object imagery, explicitly stating this gap and the novelty of your approach would strengthen your introduction.
- 4. The section "2.2. Procedure" could be shortened. I don't think the methodology should be longer than the findings section. The discussion section is also too short for the study. Please compare your study findings with similar previous ones; do they support what you found or not.
- 5. More references will also make the article more robust.
