## My Comments:

- 1. The paper is more on the morals of children and the influence of external factors on their cultural moral values than ethics. For this reason, I am of the opinion that the title is not adequate. However, if the author prefers to retain the title as it is, there is a need to briefly explain the following terms and phrases: child ethics, moral, the difference between moral, norms, and ethics, and a brief explanation of what the author means by the era of globalization.
- 2. In the Introduction section, line 9, the referencing is not the same as in others.
- 3. In the Research Method section, the author claims to have done a comprehensive search. This does not look like it because the research method does not appear to be adequate for a literature review. The author needs to explain thoroughly in the methodology the following: a) what search engines were used, how and how many; b) How many articles were reviewed; c) what the inclusion and exclusion criteria were.
- 4. In the Research Method section, lines 3 and 4, the author needs to explain how a comprehensive search and critical analysis were done.
- 5. There are no clear headings. For example, where the author has the list of factors that affect child ethics/morals, there should be 'Factors that Affect Child Ethics.'
- 6. Firstly, secondly, etc., are overly used.
- 7. All sections seem to be saying the same thing.
- 8. The paper went from introduction, research method to results and discussions with no analysis of the literatures reviewed. This is awkward.
- 9. The paper needs major revision.
