A species of anaerobic, Gram variable, rod shaped bacteria assigned to the phylum Actinobacteria. This bacteria is catalase negative, does not reduce nitrate and does not hydrolyze esculin, urea or gelatin. *A. turicensis* is most often related to genital, skin, and urinary tract infections.
