I have some expectations/suggestions that, considering them, may improve the content:

I agree with some comments about the title and with providing more details of the methodology...

I think referring for more details on the change of climate variables in the study area would improve the content of the paper, and the conclusion will be more realistic/acceptable.

Considering and/or mentioning upcoming changes in other dimensions (such as AI technology, ...) may be more necessary, or at least constructive, for *future studies*.

Referring to papers or research reports that technically focus on forecasting the extent of *events in the future* under climate change scenarios may be so useful and make conclusions more trustable.

Giving more information (graphs, tables,...) about the trend of climatic parameters and related downscaling and their consequences for time intervals from the current to 2100 (2030, 2050, 2075?) using valuable models under given scenarios was my main expectation for a paper focusing on climate change in a specific area!
