Provide a critical analysis of the existing literature to highlight gaps and justify the study's relevance.

Methodology

Authors should provide a more detailed description of the research design, data collection methods, and analytical techniques. They could also explain why specific methods were chosen and how they contribute to the reliability and

validity of the findings.

Results and Discussion

The tables and figures present the data in a clear and organized manner. They provide detailed statistical information that supports the analysis but need better integration into the text. Authors should refer to each table and figure in the text and discuss their implications in detail and ensure that all tables and figures are clearly labeled and easy to read.

The discussion effectively interprets the data, providing a nuanced understanding of the differences and similarities between Maharashtra and Jammu and Kashmir. It successfully ties the findings back to the broader context of sustainable development. But the author could be more concise by focusing on the most significant findings and their implications, avoiding repetition, and ensuring that each paragraph contributes to the overall argument.

Conclusion

The conclusion summarizes the findings but does not provide enough insight into their broader implications. Authors should discuss the broader implications of the findings for policy and practice.
